# Stereoview Photo of Nagasaki Hospital Medical Doctors

## by Wilhelm Burger

[Japan] Extremely scarce and unusual stereroview photo showing young doctors in Nagasaki relaxing together. A sake cup on the floor in front of them may explain the friendly behaviour that can be seen with one of the young man with his hand on the kimono of the man next to him. Numbered 241 and titled at the lower left of the mount, 'Doctoren aus dem Hospital von Nagasaki'. Wilhelm Burger (1844-1920) went to Japan with the Austria-Hungary mission and stayed in Nagasaki for just two weeks in September 1869 before travelling to Yokohama and then left Japan in March 1870. This particular stereoview is not listed in Terry Bennett's informative work, 'Old Japanese Photographs - Collector's Data Guide' (p.109), making it exceedingly scarce and most likely heretofore unknown.

# Pictures of A Hundred Eminent Japanese Ancient & Modern

## 2 vols. by Miki Teiichi and tr. by Takahashi Gorō

[Japan] 'with their Biographies - accompanied by an English translation made by G. Takahashi' (Vol. 1) along with 'Short Biographies of Emineni [sic] Japanese in Ancient and Modern Times each with a Characteristic Illustration' (Vol.2). Extraordinarily well-preserved pair of books with their original, woodblock printed paper sleeves. Volume 1 contains a total of ten superb, color woodblock prints by Ogata Gekkō (four), and two each by Arai Yoshimune, Toyohara Chikanobu, and Mizuno Toshikata. Volume 2 also has ten prints with five by Sensai (Kobayashi) Eitaku and five by Ogata Gekkō. Each biography is printed in Japanese, Chinese, and English.





Japan Women's University was founded in 1901 by Naruse Jinzo (1858-1919) and Okuma Shigenobu (1838-1922) with support from numerous other well-known names in Japan as shown in the book. Strangely, only one copy in Japan at Ritsumeikan University in Kyoto and a 1912 edition at some institutes outside Japan.

# Acrobats from Central India Performing in Yokohama

### by Utagawa Yoshitora

[Japan] Two very interesting woodblock prints showing acrobats apparently from 'Central India' performing in Yokohama in 1864. Yoshitora (active 1850-1880) produced some lovely work. This is one from a series of at least three single prints that he made (and these prints are not from a triptych but are each complete as issued).

[Japan] Wonderful woodblock printed vertical diptych of a young man, presumbaly a falconer, holding a falcon. Eizan (1787-1867) was considered the best of Utamaro's followers and produced a number of impressive works before turning to painting in his later life.

## Brass Protractor in Original Wooden Box

#### Cocking & Co, Yokohama

[Japan] A very scarce brass protractor that was imported and sold by Cocking & Co. of Yokohama. Samuel Cocking (1845-1914) was born in Ireland but grew up in Australia before going to Japan in 1869. His company bought and sold a wide variety of products including Japanese art and curios. He also imported scientific equipment (such as this protractor), photographic chemicals, and more. The famous Cocking Garden on Enoshima is named after him as the land was originally owned by him. The protractor itself is engraved 'Cocking & Co. Yokohama' and the original wooden box has the Cocking & Co. trademark logo imprinted in gold on the velvet lining. We believe this to be the first such Cocking protractor to be found.

Protactor longest dimension is 27.5cm (box is 28 x 20cm). c1890.

In very good condition. The box has a crack across the top but it still solid. The protractor is fine. There may have been a small part (not present) that sat on the small wooden holder in the box at top right. e35111497









# Large Format Photo around Fujiya Hotel, Hakone

## Scarce, previously unknown view

[Japan] Unusual view of what appears to be an area of the well-known Fujiya Hotel in Miyanoshita (Hakone) not often photographed. The larger building at the top would be the old Fujiya Hotel that was destroyed by fire in 1883. A Westerner dressed in a light suit and pith helmet is standing on top of the steps between two buildings. The Japanese man sitting to the left of the Japanese man in white kimono is wearing a *happi* (workman's jacket) with 'Miyanoshita' and 'Fujya' written on it in Japanese.

## CDV of Japanese Group in Hong Kong

### **Taken by Pun Lun**

[Japan] A very interesting CDV showing a group of three Japanese ladies and one Japanese man. The man is standing on one leg and has one of his straw sandals off and it is possible that they were part of an acrobatic troupe on their way to or from Europe. Various Japanese acrobats performed overseas from the mid-1860s. Pun Lun operated a very successful photographic studio in Hong Kong from around 1864. The address on the rear of 'No.56, Queen's Road' (without the word 'Central' after it probably indicates a date of 1865-1868 when he used that particular address.

## CDV of Actor playing Oiwa in Yotsuya Kaidan

### Ghost showing the effects of being poisoned

[Japan] A very unusual carte de visite showing a kabuki actor playing the ghost of Oiwa from the famous Yotsuya Kaidan ghost story. As can be seen, Oiwa is partially bald because her hair would fall out when she combed it as a result of being poisoned by her husband (or others depending on the version of the story). We can see her combs in front of her and she also has the drooping eye which was also as a result of the poison. Her baby lies on the floor nearby. This is the first such Meiji-era photo of an actor playing Oiwa that we have seen.
